What is SASA?

Our Mission is to educate, engage, and mobilize students to promote the expansion of and access to STEM programs.

SASA runs the FIRST National Advocacy Conference annually every June in Washington, DC and promotes state advocacy efforts within the FIRST and STEM communities.

The association was started in 2020 by the founders of the National Advocacy Conference in an effort to strengthen, coordinate, and grow advocacy efforts by and for students.

What will the funds be used for?

Initially, the funds will be used for basic SASA operations including the technical systems needed for eblasting and tracking membership as well as the finances of the organization. This will include a web based membership portal system.

Ultimately, in the future, as we build membership, we will look to contract advocacy services at the national level and potentially in different states as needed to proactively formulate and push STEM friendly legislation and opportunities for students. When we reach this, we will develop our own advocacy platform complete with issue briefs on various topics that can be used by our members to increase the effectiveness of their advocacy.
