



- NDAA
 - 1/4 of 1 % of DoD contracts to support high-quality STEM education
- CHIPS & Science Act of 2022
 - STEM Education Directorate and Advancing Informal STEM Learning (AISL)
- Funding for ESSA Title IV Part A & B
- Title IV A was funded at \$1.38B in Fiscal Year 2024, annually given out to every public school in America
 - Title IV B 21st Century Community Learning Centers funded at 1.33B in FY24







